By public transport

Travel by rail to East Croydon.

The station at East Croydon is 20 minutes walk away and is served by trains from the following main line stations:
Journey Time Frequency, Kings Cross Thameslink 35 mins every 22 mins, Victoria 16 mins every 6-8 mins, London Bridge 20 mins every 20 mins, Blackfriars 28 mins every 15 mins.

By Foot

Come out of the station and turn right into George Street. Cross over first set of traffic lights. Walk straight ahead passing The Co-Operative Bank, McDonalds and Barclays Bank. At second set of traffic lights cross over and keep walking until you pass Alders. On the opposite side of the road is The American Express Bureau de Change. Walk towards it and turn left which takes you into the High Street. The Post Office is on the same side of the road. Keep walking straight ahead towards the Croydon Flyover. Walk under it and keep going until you reach Connexions. At this point cross over and Grosvenor House is on the opposite side of the road.

From the M25

Leave the motorway at the M25 junction 7 and head towards Croydon and London. The motorway will end and the road becomes the A23. Follow the A23 until you arrive at the large roundabout at Purley (there is a large Tesco store on the right as you approach). At the roundabout take the road straight ahead marked as the A235 for Croydon. Stay on the A235 for around 2-3 miles. You will eventually pass a tall building on your right marked Leon House. The Croydon Flyover will now be around 300 metres ahead. Pass under the flyover and turn left immediately into Whitgift Street. Proceed to the T-junction and turn left into Wandle Street. A landmark 50 yards away from the centre is Croydon library and clock tower. If asking for directions you should use this to identify where you wish to go. The public car park now on your left will cost around £9.00 per day (long-stay only).
